BR-100M

This is a professional handheld dynamic microphone with a cardioid polar pattern. It's made with an alloy of zinc, giving it a bright and smooth surface for the ultimate comfort, grip, and professional look.

Usage:

1. Before turning on your amplifier or mixing board, set the microphone volume to low. Then turn on phantom power and raise the volume to your desire. This is to avoid a pounding sound when powering on your gear.
2. Keep the microphone distant from the speaker to avoid feedback or howling noises.
3. For the best gain and output, place the microphone close to your mouth or desired sound source.

Connecting and disconnecting your microphone:

1. Align XLR cable with the 3 connection prongs on the bottom of the handheld microphone. Then insert the XLR into the bottom of the microphone until you hear a sealing click. Now connect the other end of the cable into your desired audio device.
2. To disconnect your microphone, reverse the instructions in step 1.

Caution:

1. It is important to keep out foreign particles from entering the windscreen of the microphone as it may alter the frequency response. The windscreen is also known as the grill or head cover.
2. Avoid shock to the microphone as it is highly sensitive. Dropping it, hitting it, or handling without care may affect the components within the microphone.
3. To maintain sensitivity and quality of reproduction, avoid exposing microphone to hot or moist temperatures.
